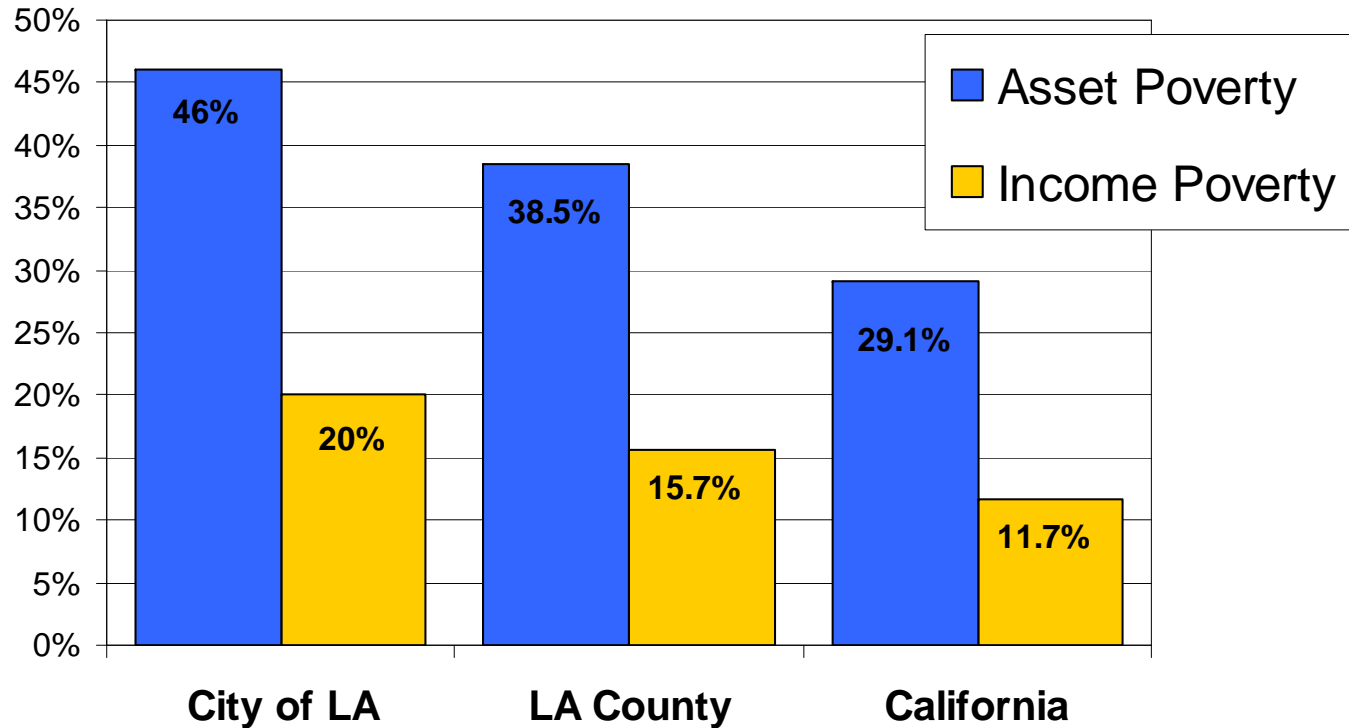
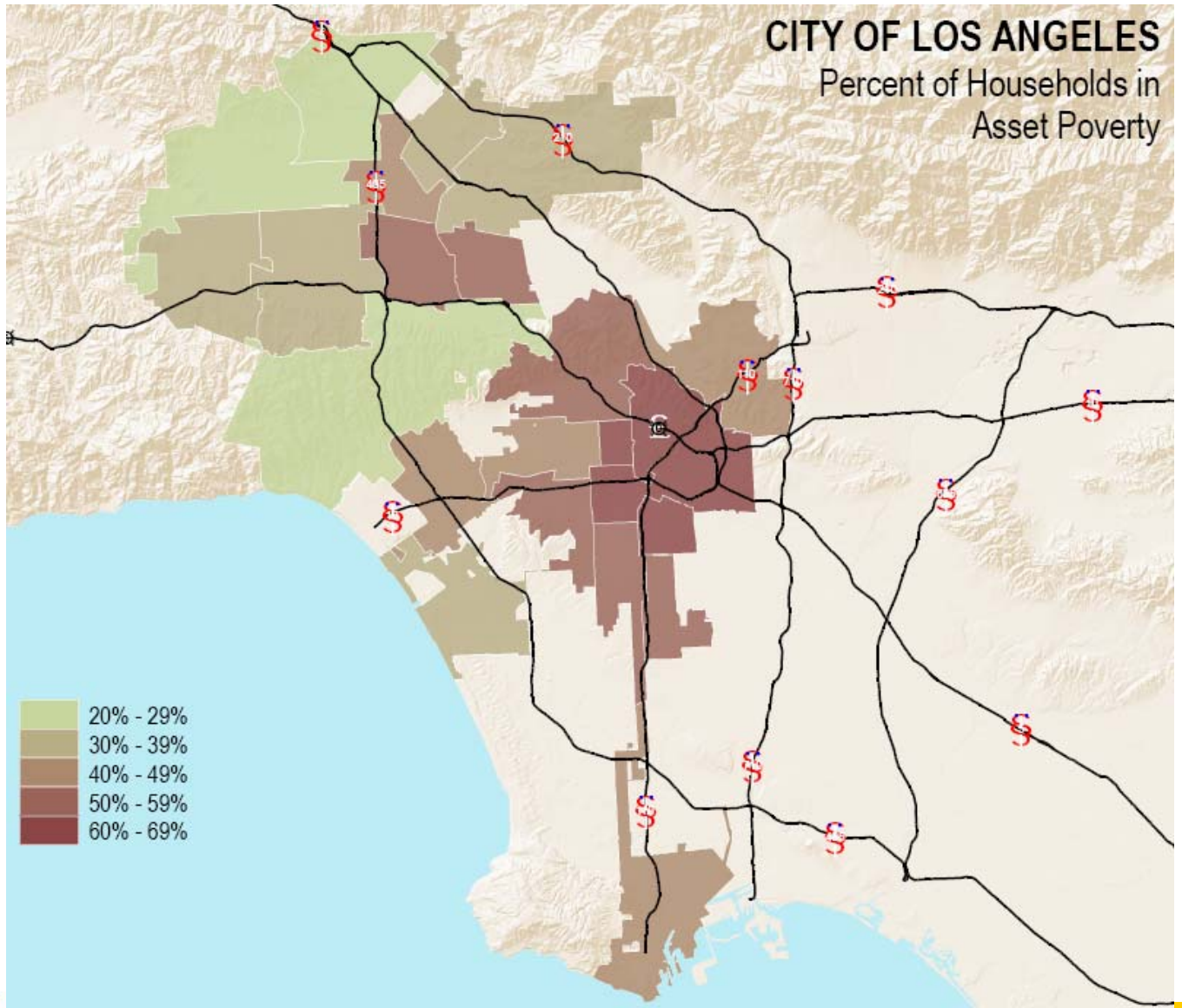

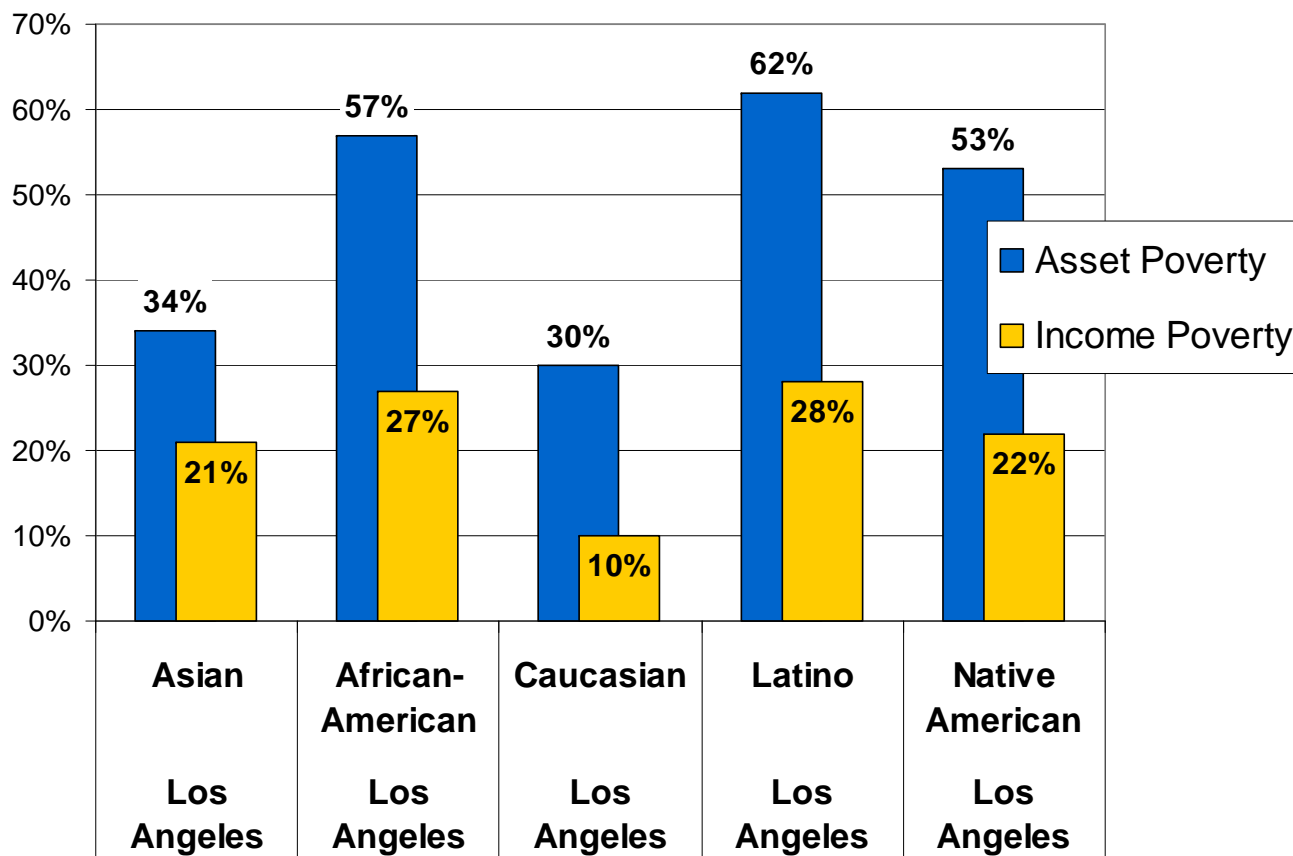

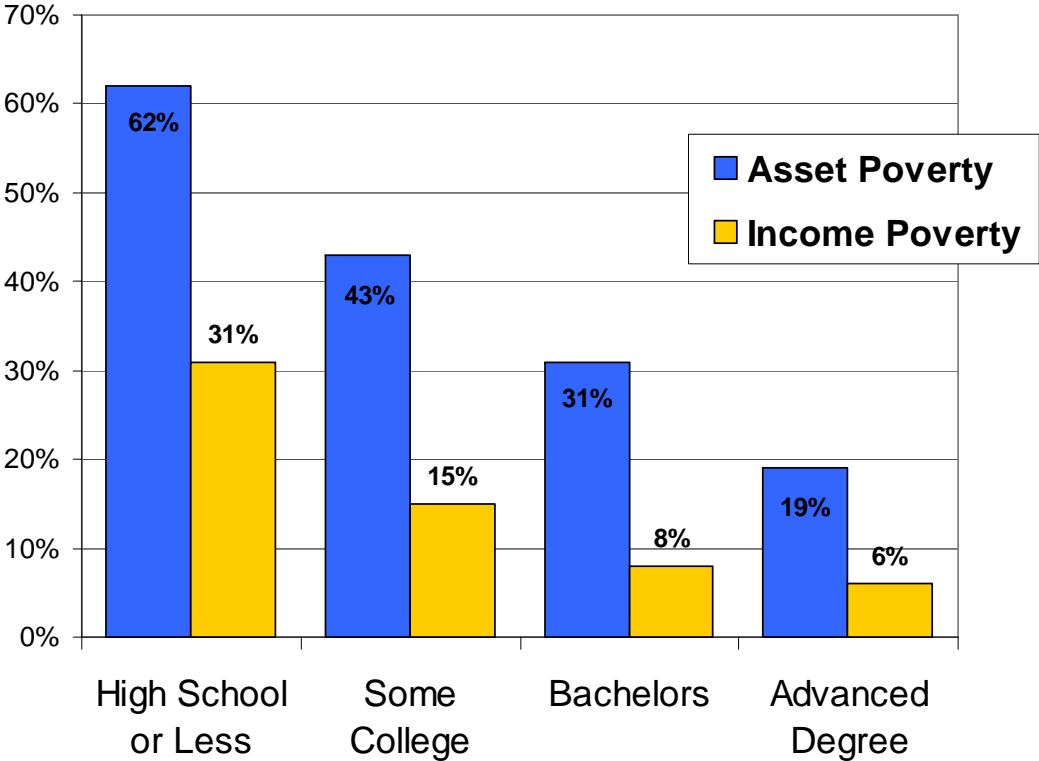
Percent of Households in
